QUALIFICATION RULES FOR THE 4, 5, 6 & 7 YEAR OLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

BRITISH 5, 6 & 7 YEAR OLD

1. Horse/Rider combinations will be awarded points on their placing in each of the two qualifiers (they must start in both). The total of these points will produce a league table from which the top 50 (minimum) will qualify for the finals.
2. Any combination jumping clear in both qualifiers will be guaranteed a place in the final. In the event of equality for the final qualifying place in the league table, the combination with the highest place from the second qualifier will qualify.
3. For every 10 entries above 50, 1 extra qualifying place will be allotted to each final.
4. Any horse which is eliminated due to two refusals in any qualifier will not be eligible to compete in the finals. Points will be awarded as follows: -
1st = 1 point, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 4 points, etc. until all those that competed in the class are awarded points.
The horse with the least points will be ranked number 1. As competitors will be placed equal, then the points awarded will be added and divided by the number of horses equally placed (i.e. if five horses are equal 1st then we add 1+2+3+4+5 = 15, then divide by 5 meaning each horse receives a total of 3 points).
5. 6 year olds: any horse jumping a treble clear in one of the Big Star qualifiers will automatically be eligible for the BIG STAR BONUS which will be awarded in the SEIB 6 Year Old Final. The highest placed eligible horse will receive £1,000.

BRITISH 4 YEAR OLD CHAMPIONSHIP

All horses jumping clear in either of the qualifiers will be eligible to compete in the Final. Horses do not have to start in both qualifiers to be eligible to compete in the Final.

CLEAR ROUND BONUS PRIZES sponsored by British Showjumping

- Any 4 year old horse that qualifies for the Final then jumps double clear in the Final will receive a share of a £2,000 Prize Fund.
- Any 5 year old horse that jumps clear in both qualifiers and then clear in both rounds of the Final will receive a share of a £4,000 Prize Fund.
- Any 6 year old horse that jumps clear in both qualifiers and then clear in both rounds of the Final will receive a share of a £4,000 Prize Fund.
- Any 7 year old horse that jumps clear in both qualifiers and then clear in both rounds of the Final will receive a share of a £4,000 Prize Fund.

BRITISH BREEDERS' PRIZES sponsored by British Showjumping

Breeders of the top 5 British bred horses in their respective Finals will receive the following prizes: -

PRIZES: £850, £450, £300, £200, £200 (in the 4 Year Old Final, £2,000 will be split between the breeders of any British bred horses jumping a double clear)

These prizes have been kindly sponsored by British Showjumping and will be distributed following the Championships by British Showjumping Head Office. Any discrepancy in the allocation of this prize money will be referred to the British Showjumping Performance Committee.

BIG STAR BONUS sponsored by British Showjumping

6 year olds: any horse jumping a treble clear in one of the Big Star qualifiers taking place between May and July will automatically be eligible for the Big Star Bonus which will be awarded in the SEIB British 6 Year Old Final. The highest placed eligible horse will receive £1,000.

FEI WORLD BREEDING CHAMPIONSHIPS - INFORMATION

The British Young Horse Championships is the qualifying show for the World Breeding Championship for Young Horses in Lanaken (BEL). The top four British bred horses, holding British-based breed passports, in the 5 and 6 year old Finals, will qualify. The top three British bred horses, holding British-based breed passports, will also qualify in the 7 year old Final. 'Wildcards' will be awarded to the top four non-British bred 5 & 6 year olds and the top three non-British bred 7 year old in their respective Finals (these would also include British Breeds without British-based passports), and these will be forwarded to Zangersheide for their consideration (please see the Zangersheide rules below). Minimum eligibility requirements – 5 year olds must have jumped 3 clear rounds at 1.15m; 6 year olds, 1.25m; 7 year olds, 1.35m, in the current year.

- **British Bred Horses:** Great Britain is allocated a certain number of places to enter horses from a studbook which is domiciled in GB.
 - **Foreign Bred Horses:** Will only be accepted via an application for a wildcard.
- a. The Organising Committee will only accept entries for wildcards made by the concerning National Federations invited by the OC.
 - b. Horses that wish to be eligible to receive a wildcard must be registered at a studbook which is a member of the WBFSH.
 - c. Wildcards can be provided to horses which for instance qualified themselves but have not been selected as their native country is not the same as their country of residence. The Organising Committee, in accordance with the FEI, has the right to adjust the number of quotas in case too many qualified horses apply for a wildcard. This might be the case when in the country they have qualified themselves, the National Federation does not want to take them in their quota. This is to keep the number of horses from one breeding area in proportion.
 - d. National Federations who have been given a quota cannot apply for wildcards for horses that are registered in the national studbooks of the nation of that National Federation.
 - e. All applications for wildcards must be motivated by the National Federations and should be accompanied with show results. These results must be faxed or sent by email to the organiser.
 - f. The OC will not provide wildcards for horses that have participated at young horse competitions without success.
 - g. After the closing date for the definite entries, all National Federations will be advised about the provided wildcards.
 - h. The Organising Committee, in consultation with the FEI, will decide upon wildcards; no further appeal is possible.
 - i. Wildcards are only provided to specific selected horses. Once these horses are selected, they cannot be substituted by a National Federation. Only the Organising Committee can allow substitutions.
 - j. Only horses selected by the Team Manager will be able to apply for a wildcard.

- ✓ Permanent Loss of Use cover as a result of Accidental External Injury or illness/disease*
- ✓ £10,000 vet fees cover (per claim and within the policy year)
- ✓ Buying cover for conditions/areas of the horse's anatomy that may be subject to an exclusion*



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RULES FOR SHOWJUMPING EXHIBITORS

SUBSTITUTIONS AND LATE ENTRIES

Substitutions may be allowed in jumping competitions at the discretion of the Executive, provided the animal substituted is in the same ownership. If an animal is upgraded before a competition, it may be transferred to another appropriate competition. Late and amended entries, if taken at the show, will be charged an extra £5 per class.

ORDER OF JUMPING

Horses and ponies must jump in the order in which they appear on the starting list, unless special permission has been obtained from the Lead Official. Any competitor missing their turn may be eliminated from the competition. During the competition three competitors must always be ready to enter the arena. If a competitor does not respond when they are called, they lose their turn and may be eliminated from the competition in progress.

UNACCOMPANIED COMPETITORS

Unaccompanied competitors must provide the Show Organiser with a contact telephone number in case of an emergency.

DECLARATIONS

Declarations for all the age championships and consolation finals must be made by 5.00pm on the previous evening.

STALLIONS

"Rule 82.19 No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury". Also refer to Rule 102.13.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATES

All horses and ponies entering the Showground must be vaccinated according to the following requirements, and vaccination certificates/passports must accompany the horse or pony to the show and be available for checking: Horses/ponies must have received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can compete in competitions. In addition, a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year apart. Horses/ponies must have received the full course of vaccinations or the booster at least 7 days prior to the competition date, and not more than 1 year after the previous booster.

There will be no tolerance of Equine Influenza vaccination certificates that do not meet show protocol. If discrepancies are found, this will result in the horse being sent home immediately, without competing and/or any prizes will be forfeited.

HICKSTEAD GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. FORFEITURE OF FEES AND CHARGES

If entries are cancelled after the closing date, half the entry fee will be refunded on production of a current vet's certificate. We regret no stabling charges can be refunded (other than in accordance with British Showjumping Rules). Should any competition be cancelled because of bad weather or for any reason, entry fees will be refunded. It is regretted that stabling and other charges cannot be refunded.

2. DRESS

In accordance with British Showjumping Rule 101.

3. VAT RATES

All entry fees are exempt from VAT. Stabling, first aid and starting fees are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate.

4. TIMETABLE AND CLASS LISTS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to move classes to other rings or change times as they think fit. Riders whose horses are not stabled at Hickstead are strongly advised to check the Hickstead website www.hickstead.co.uk after 8.00pm for revised times.

5. VEHICLES

The Executive reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended and the Executive will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage caused by such removal.

6. MOTORBIKES, BICYCLES & ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

In the interests of safety of competitors and members of the public, the riding of bicycles, motorcycles, electric scooters, mopeds, etc. is FORBIDDEN anywhere on the Hickstead Showground. Anybody contravening this rule will be sent off the Showground.

7. FIRE PRECAUTION

The County Fire Officer of West Sussex has ordered that all horse boxes and caravans parked in the Stable Field must carry a fire extinguisher and be fitted with a working smoke alarm. You may be asked to leave if you are without them.

8. STABLING

All stabling will be on the ground in either permanent or hired boxes. Stabling will be made available for the period of the show ONLY at £170 inc VAT & muck removal per box (£195 for a barn stable). No bookings will be taken for shorter periods. No horses or people may come on the showground before 10am on Wednesday, 12th August. Due to fire regulations, it is regretted that straw is banned from the Stable Field. Stables will not be bedded down in advance. Due to the escalating cost of muck removal, exhibitors will be charged £6 per stable to go towards the cost of this service. EXTRA SHAVINGS, HAY AND FORAGE CAN BE PURCHASED IN THE STABLE FIELD ON A DAILY BASIS. Deliveries of forage and bedding from alternative suppliers will be strictly prohibited. Exhibitors are expected to leave their stables in a clean state - failure to do so may result in future expulsion from Hickstead. No horses or ponies may be kept in horseboxes overnight. Exhibitors who have not booked stabling will not be admitted to the Stable Field until the day of their competition. Stallion owners are required to bring their own electric packs. Unruly or dangerous animals may be asked to leave the showground.

9. HORSEBOXES

It is a requirement to put your mobile telephone number on your horsebox pass which must be displayed in the windscreen. It is prohibited for any exhibitor or associate to interfere with another exhibitor's horsebox.

10. **CARAVANS AND LIVED-IN HORSE BOXES**

There will be a limit of one caravan or one lived-in horse box per exhibitor for every three horses which they enter for the show. There will be no charge. Exhibitors with generators on their horseboxes must turn them off by 10.00pm. This ruling will be strictly enforced by Stable Field Security. Exhibitors who fail to comply with this ruling will be asked to leave the showground.

11. **PRIZE MONEY**

Prize money will be paid directly by BACS into your nominated bank account post show.

12. **PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING**

No professional photography is allowed on the showground except with permission obtained from the Press Office. It is understood and agreed by any competitor attending the show that permission is granted to Hickstead Ltd for any photographs and/or film footage taken at the show by any official photographer or film company to be used by them for security, promotional, live streaming and/or broadcasting purposes, furthermore the competitor agrees that permission is without any payment.

13. **ANY COMPETITOR** found riding in the ring without permission will be disqualified from the show and reported to the Stewards of British Showjumping. All warming up must be done in the area provided. No one is allowed on the showground in the evenings or up to an hour before the first class in the morning. Any person riding their horses anywhere other than in the permitted areas will be subject to disciplinary action by the Executive and may be ordered off the showground.

14. The Executive reserves the right to use images of competitors at Hickstead for any promotional purpose.

15. The Executive reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions as they think fit.

16. The Executive may in any dispute or other matter whatsoever, act or decide in any manner they think fit (saving British Showjumping rules). All objections and complaints must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £100 under British Showjumping rule 198.

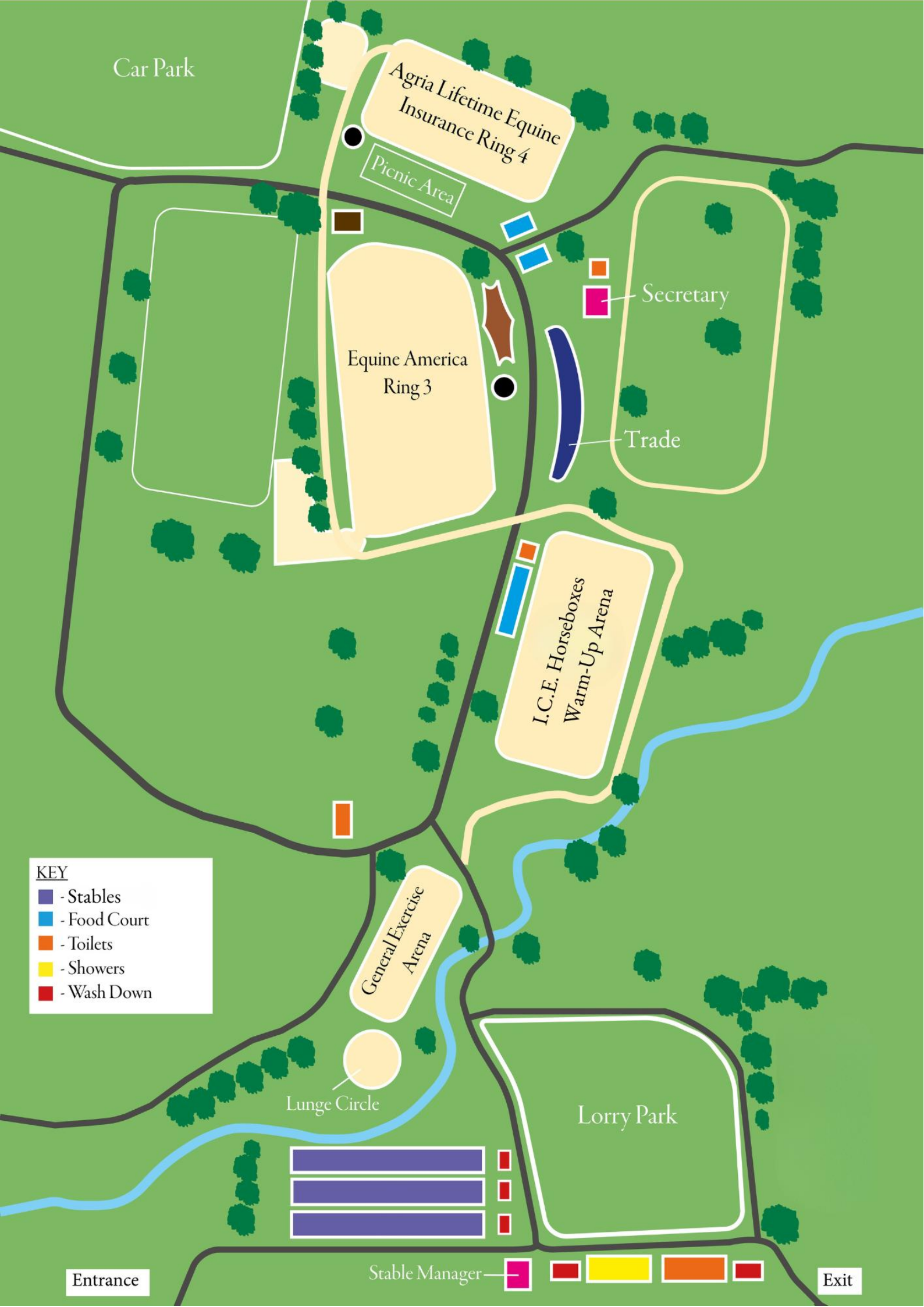
