The Hurst College National Schools Jumping Championships

This year sees the 61st running of the National Schools Jumping Championships at Hickstead on Friday 27th June. Although not ideal for everyone, we feel this date is the most suitable as it must follow one of our main events if we are to continue to give the children the opportunity to compete in the International Arena.

Allowing individual competitors in both the Junior Schools (now 85cms) and Senior Schools (now 1.00m) divisions has proved very popular and will continue this year. Reserve riders (max 2 per team) and schools unable to field a team (max 2 per school) may jump as an individual at the conclusion of the preliminary team competition in the outside ring. All those jumping a clear round (including riders who are part of a team that does not qualify) will qualify to jump in the International Arena at the conclusion of the Team Championship.

All Finals will be run as Single Phase. Faults and time will be used to decide all team and individual placings in the International Arena.

Schools' teams are open to four riders, with the best three scores to count. The Hickstead Elite 1.10m NSEA Individual Championship will again kick off proceedings in the International Arena.

Please note, all entries must be completed online at <u>EquiLive</u> by 13th June. Just go to the website using your PC, tablet or phone and register your school, your riders, and their horses, and then you'll be able to log in to your account to add your entries.
